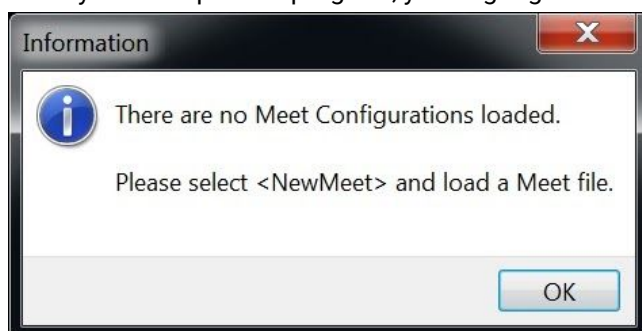
## DiveSheets Program

When a competition uses DiveRecorder, [DiveSheets](#) is a program for uploading the dive sheets for multiple divers at once, such as by a coach or the club's sports administrator. Alternatively, divers or coaches can enter their own sheets directly online one at a time: [link](#).

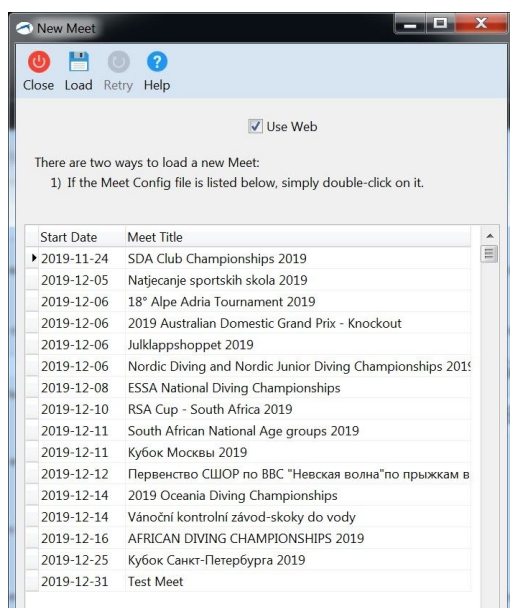
How to install: go to the [Downloads page](#) of the [DiveRecorder](#) website and install the DRUtils to a Windows computer.

## Step-by-step

When you first open the program, you might get the warning below. Just click OK:

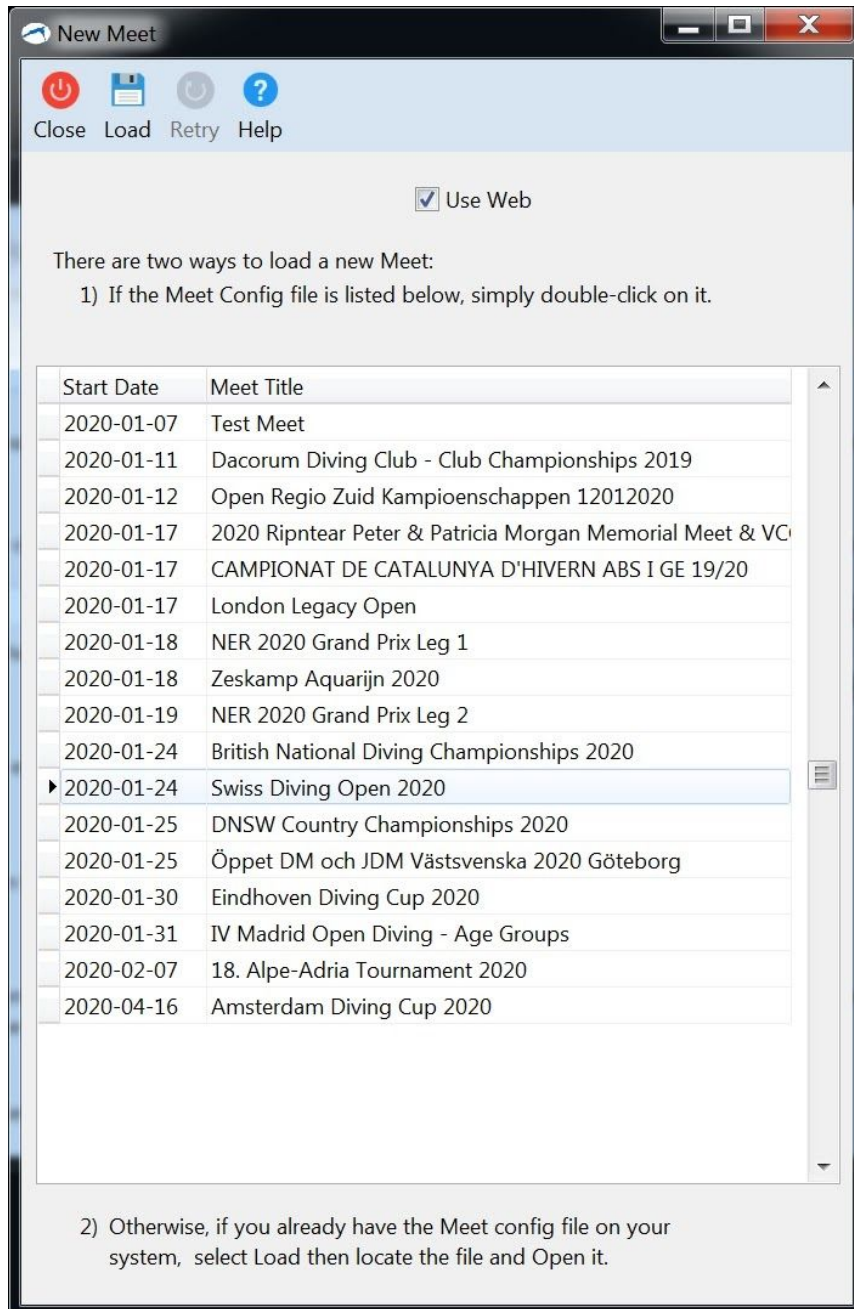


First select a meet, the Swiss Open in this case. However, it might not appear in the list if the use web box is not checked:



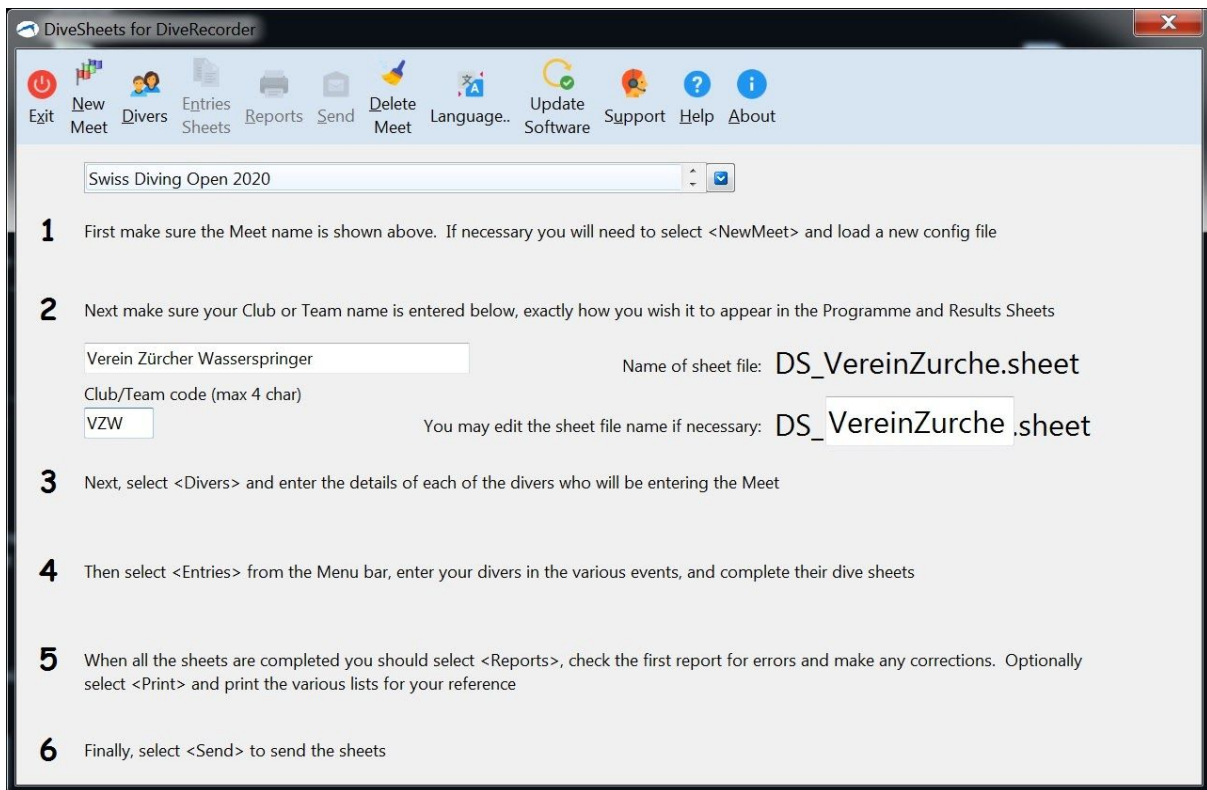
In this case, please select the "Use Web" box and choose "Close". (That will save the selection.)

When you then reopen the meet selection, Swiss Open should appear:

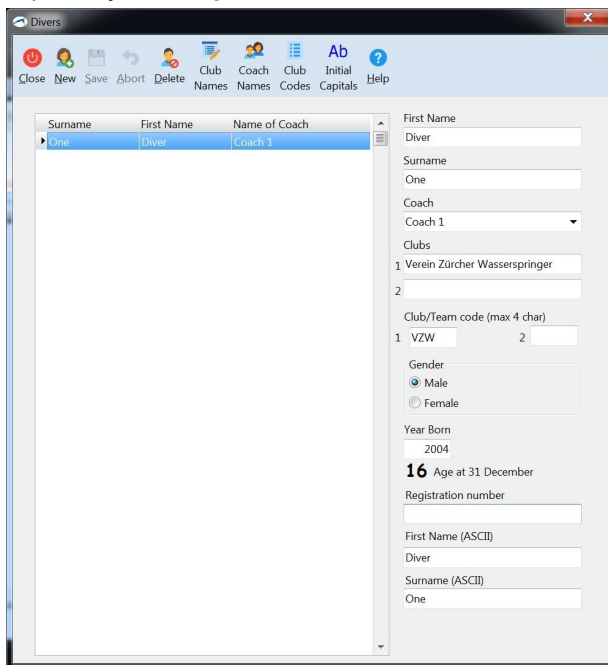


Select it and close (or double click).
